

Japanese panel



The Japanese Panel is a blind especially designed both to cover large glass surfaces and to separate areas in multi-purpose spaces. Using the operating mechanism of the blind (cord or handle) or by pulling the fabric manually, the slats can be gathered to the side to allow more or less light into the room.

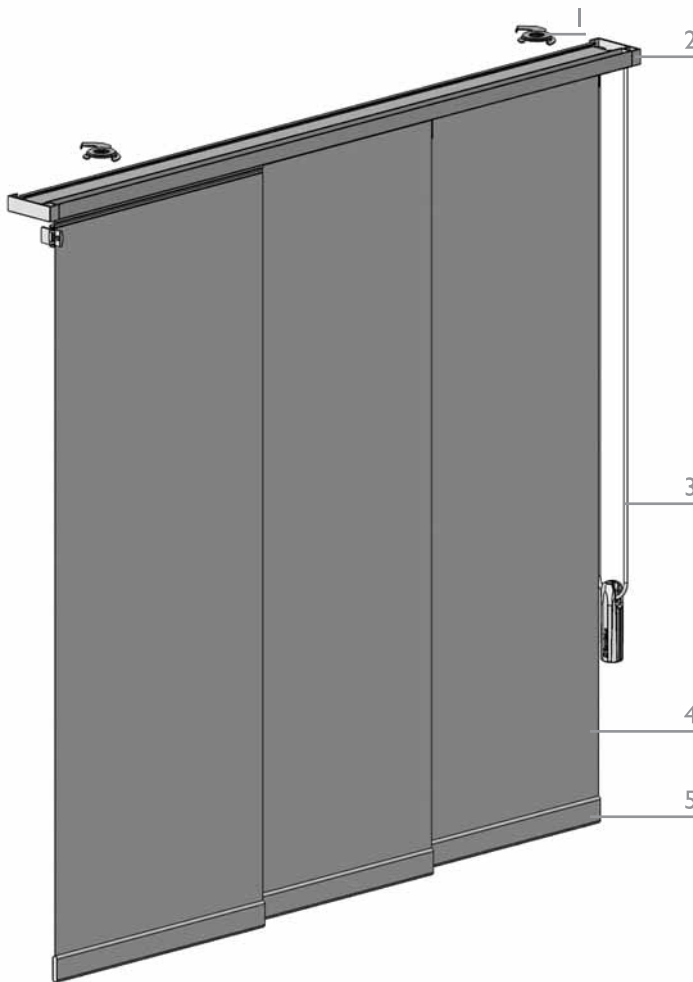
The uniformity and behaviour of the fabric on this type of blind transforms any type of room into a modern setting, giving it a highly decorative and technical look.

Descriptive specifications:

Manual operational system with 3,5mm polyester cord or wand.

- 1 - Fixing bracket
- 2 - Sliding panel headrail 2, 3, 4 or 5 tracks
- 3 - Cord weight pulley
- 4 - Technical or decorative fabric (according to Bandalux Catalogue)
- 5 - Bottom weight

Bandalux has developed 3 operating systems that allow this type of blind to be manufactured with technical and decorative fabrics:

- ▶ **Free movement:** The panels move independently.
- ▶ **Interlocked movement:** The panels move by means of a handle and as it moves it pulls the other panels to the desired position.
- ▶ **Cord operation:** The operating mechanism allows the panels to move laterally, centrally or toward either end.

The blind is made up of an upper aluminium profile of 2, 3, 4 or 5 lacquered rails on which the lacquered aluminium carriers slide exactly as the upper profile.

The panel blind from Bandalux is made up of several panels of fabric arranged vertically, which are retained from above by means of a closing tape connected to an aluminium profile called a carrier profile which hangs and slides across other profile tracks on an aluminium profile called the rail.

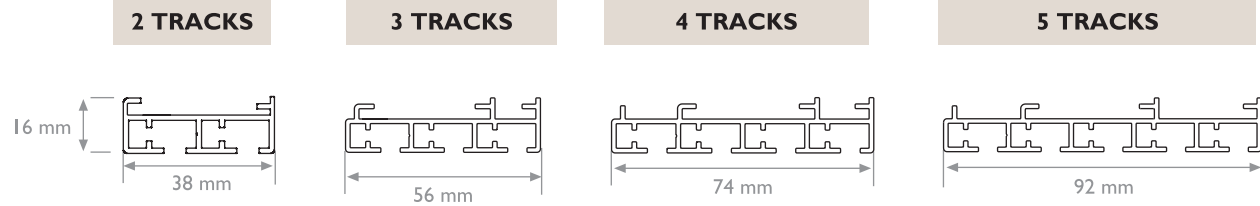
The blind has a 25 x 5mm concealed lower aluminium profile inserted at the bottom of each panel as a counterweight to guarantee that the fabric falls correctly.

The system is easily installed on either ceilings or walls.





All components and mechanisms are available in 3 different colours.
